Procedure for applying:

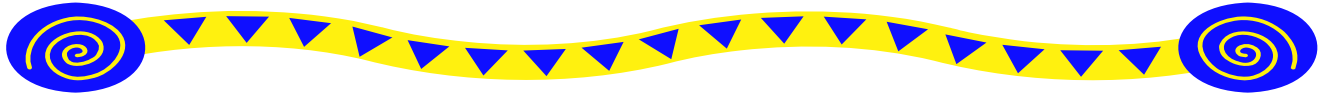
1. Submit a copy of your undergraduate transcript (transfer students must submit transcripts from previous institutions of higher education attended).
2. Submit two letters of recommendation from members of the faculty familiar with your academic work.
3. Submit a (maximum) two-page, typed essay that discusses why you are deserving of this award, your major academic interest and how your current studies relate to your future professional or intellectual development.
4. Submit a brief resume indicating any relevant academic prizes, community and work experience or research projects.
