Procedure for applying:

- Senior Honors theses are eligible.
- Papers written in Spanish are acceptable.
- Papers must be between 10 and 40 pages long (typed double-spaced) and will be judged by a LACS-Faculty committee on the basis of originality, research and strength of argument and writing.
- Papers are eligible from any Stony Brook class, including listed LACS-Minor courses.
